



South Sacramento Phase 2 Corridor Project

CONNECT WITH PHASE 2 - ATTEND AN OPEN HOUSE MEETING

The Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) is completing conceptual engineering for the South Line Phase 2 project, and is currently evaluating the environmental impacts of project alternatives including constructing and operating the proposed light rail extension. Upon RT's review and approval for public release of the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement/Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (DSEIS/SEIR), RT will initiate the formal public review process which will include public hearings expected to be held later this year. The project has benefited from ongoing public outreach conducted as part of the scoping process, in which numerous comments were received from participating agencies and from the public. RT invites you to attend an informational Open House meeting to see how the project has evolved since the scoping period.

Attend an Open House Meeting near you to gather information on:

- Proposed alignment for the light rail extension
- Environmental issues identified to date
- Overall construction schedule and construction phasing options
- Other related projects

You are invited to drop by anytime during an informal open house between 6:00 and 8:00 PM. Technical staff will be on hand to discuss the project with you and to answer any related questions. Welcoming remarks will be provided by Dr. Beverly Scott, Sacramento Regional Transit General Manager/CEO, and elected officials, after which the open house portion of the meeting will resume. Both meetings will present the same information.

BACKGROUND

Expansion of the light rail system has been identified as the locally preferred means of accommodating transportation needs associated with the population and employment growth in the Southern Sacramento Region. RT began light rail operations in 1987 with a route linking Downtown Sacramento with suburbs to the east and north. The first extension of Sacramento's light rail system was completed in 1998 with the opening of the Mather Field/Mills Station. Currently, the system is being expanded into the City of Folsom and into South Sacramento with the construction of South Line Phase 1, a 6.3-mile extension to Meadowview Road. The South Line Phase 1 and Folsom light rail extensions are scheduled to open for service by September 2003 and April 2005 respectively. The second phase of the South Line extension, South Line Phase 2, proposes to extend the light rail system approximately 5 miles farther from Meadowview Road to the intersection of Calvine/Auberry.
